

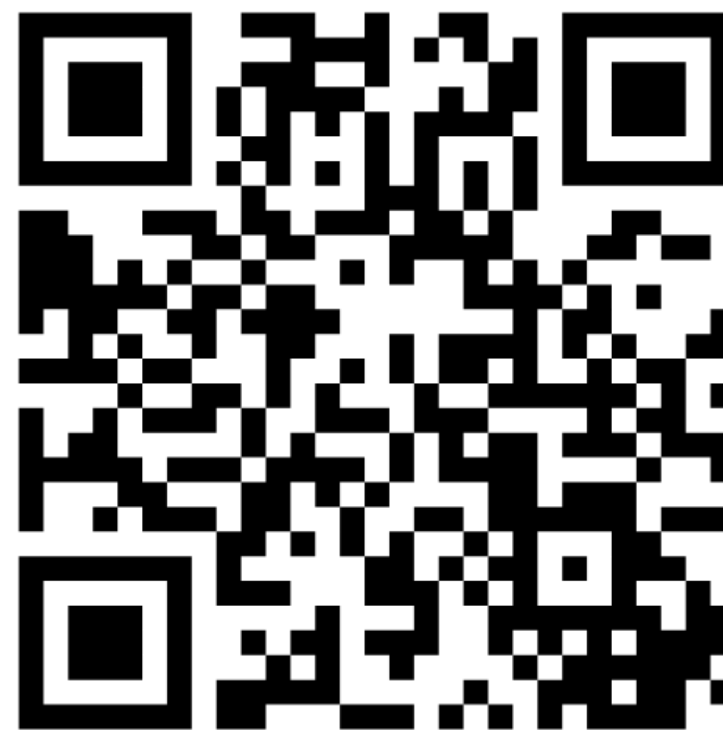

Library Search

<https://library-search.imperial.ac.uk>

- ALWAYS log in
- Material across all 7 libraries, including print
- E-access limitations in notes
- No restrictions on number of users
- No restrictions on e-books via this method
- Good for initial topic search
- Requesting items via Document Delivery service

- Library Search – access to any resource
- Other subject pages – Computing, Maths, EEE...?
- Recommending resources

Reading lists

- Accessed via your class module page
- Can be viewed via website
- Should all be available online.
- Any issues accessing lists, contact Ann or Dan, or module lead
- Reading lists should be a springboard to other, extensive reading.

“I can’t find...”

The book is on the catalogue but not on the shelf – help!

- Is it on loan? Check status in Library Search.
- If on loan, put a request on it.
- If not on loan, ask Information Hub for assistance.

The item isn’t on the catalogue so where is it?

- Double-check Library Search.
- Request via Document Delivery service OR
- Let me know!

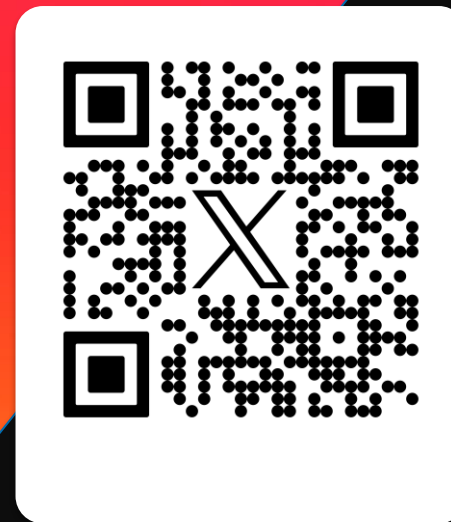
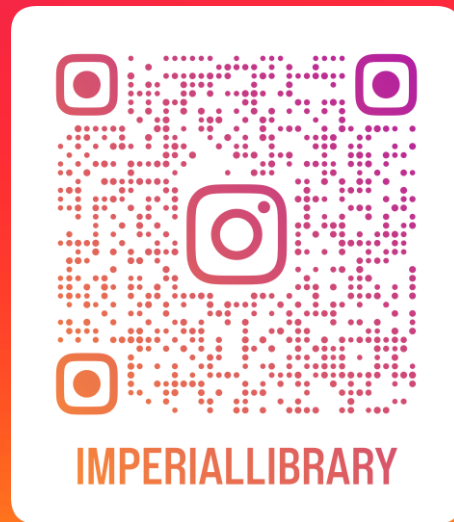
